

Camping Rules

1. Safety is our primary concern, members are asked to observe the speed limits of 15 MPH on club grounds except in the camping area which is 10 MPH.
2. A member must move their camping unit to another campground under the following conditions:
After the camping unit is resting on a site for a period of seven (7) days through sixteen (16) days the member must move their unit to another campground for at least seven (7) days or remove the unit from the campgrounds for a period of two (2) days before returning to the campground you left. Members must occupy their camping unit when placed on a site in the campground. After staying for a period of five (5) continuous days including a full weekend the member may leave the unit unattended for two (2) days. The two (2) days unattended can only be used on the following days of the week-Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday.
3. Only one camping unit is allowed per site. Camping unit is defined as a motorhome, travel trailer, 5th wheel trailer or fold down trailer.
4. Black water must be dumped at a dump station only.
5. Members are expected to deposit all trash in proper containers.
6. Fires are to be confined to fire rings or pits. Fire rings or pits shall not be moved. No trash of any kind is to be disposed in the fire rings.
7. Members are to respect each others enjoyment of the campgrounds. No loud noises or music is allowed between 11 P.M. and 8 A.M..
8. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed only in moderation and with discretion.
9. Bicycle riders must obey speed limits. No bicycle riding after dark.
10. Member and guest use of the facilities is at their own risk. The Waterloo Sportsman's Club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to member or guest property.
11. Adult members are responsible for and accountable for the conduct and actions of their family and guest.
12. Members are expected to clean up site when leaving.
13. Do not drive nails or other objects into trees. Lanterns must be hung at least 12 inches from trees.
14. Absolutely no fish cleaning in the campground.
15. Firewood is to be used in a responsible manner. Cost is \$1.00 per rack.
16. One vehicle per used campsite in the campground. Extra vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.
17. Pet rules: All pets must be kept on leash when outside of camper. Pets must be kept quiet and inside campers at night.
18. Clean up after pets.
