## Park and Fishing Rules

---

1. No wading or swimming in the lakes.
2. Fishing from a Coast Guard approved tube wader is approved.
3. No littering of lake or picnic grounds with any refuse or throwing of rocks into the lakes.
4. Members may have (2) two guest fishermen per member per day. Guest fishing fees may that have been established by the Board of Directors are posted and are payable at the boat house. Children 13 and under need not pay to fish, but will be counted as a guest.
5. Number of adult guests for ground privileges to be limited to 10 per member at any one time and everyone must register. Organizations, by permission of President only.
6. A member's immediate family may use the member's card. Unmarried children under 21 may exercise fishing and park rights with the exception of bringing guests. They must have the member's card with them. The parents are responsible for their conduct.
7. Fishing in the lake will not be permitted with goldfish or carp minnows.
8. Every member must register before fishing in the lakes, must show membership card upon request and must sign out when leaving, stating the number and type of fish taken.
9. Night fishing will be allowed on all lakes except the Kids Lake until 11 pm during Daylight Savings Time. This rule is on a trial basis.
10. Only electric trolling motors permitted on the lake.
11. Private boats are permitted on the lakes as directed by the Board of Directors.
12. Parking in marked areas only.
13. All amplified and/or live music must stop at 12:00 midnight. At this time Quiet Hour rules will become effective. Persons using the Main Pavilion area that are going to have live bands and/or amplified music shall be restricted to inside the Main Pavilion.
14. Members are to respect each other's enjoyment of the club grounds. No loud noises or music is allowed between 11 pm and 8 am.
15. Fish will not be cleaned in the park area. Fish shall be cleaned at the fish cleaning stand provided for this purpose.
16. No jugging, trout line or tree line fishing allowed.
17. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed only in moderation and with discretion.
18. Bicycle riders must obey speed limits. No bicycling after dark.
19. Member and guest use of the facilities is at their own risk. The Waterloo Sportsman's Club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to member or guest property.
20. Adult members are responsible and accountable for the conduct of their family and guests.
