

Park and Fishing Rules

1. No wading or swimming in the lakes.
2. Fishing from a Coast Guard approved tube wader is approved.
3. No littering of lake or picnic grounds with any refuse or throwing of rocks into the lakes.
4. Members may have two guest fishermen per member per day. Guest fishing fees may be established by the Board of Directors, posted and payable at the boat house. Children 13 or under need not pay to fish. But will be counted as a guest.
5. Number of adult guests for ground privileges to be limited to 10 per member at any one time and everyone must register. Organizations by permission of President only.
6. A member's immediate family may use the member's card. Unmarried children under 21 may exercise fishing and park rights with the exception of bringing guests. They must have the member's card with them. The parents are responsible for their conduct.
7. In number 1 lake bass 15 ¾ inch and under can be kept, 16 inches and over are to be returned to lake unharmed.
8. Fishing in the lake will not be permitted with goldfish or carp minnows.
9. Every member must register before fishing in the lakes and must show membership card upon request and must sign out when leaving stating the number and kind of fish taken.
10. Night fishing will be allowed on all lakes except Kids lake until 11 P.M. during Daylight Savings Time. This rule is on a trial basis.
11. Only electric trolling motors permitted on the lake.
12. Private boats are permitted on the lakes as directed by the Board of Directors.
13. Parking in marked areas only.
14. All amplified and/or live music must stop at 12:00 midnight. At this time Quiet Hour rules will become effective.
15. Members are to respect each other's enjoyment of the club grounds. No loud noises or music is allowed Between 11 P.M. and 8 A.M..
16. Fish will not be cleaned in the park area, only at the fish cleaning stand provided for this purpose.
17. No jugging, trout line, tree line fishing allowed.
18. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed only in moderation and with discretion.
19. Bicycle rider must obey speed limits. No bicycle riding after dark.
20. Member and guest use of the facilities is at their own risk. The Waterloo Sportsman's Club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to member or guest property.
21. Adult members are responsible for and accountable for the conduct and actions of their family and guests.

Crappie – 10 fish 10" or longer
Carp – No Limit

Blue Catfish – 1 per membership card
